### **Important**

There have been a series of very high spore counts in the MID, West Gippsland and Orbost regions in the last week.

All farmers in these regions are advised to implement preventative measures in both your milking herd and dry stock as a matter of urgency if you have not done so already.

Farmers in other regions are advised to continue to closely monitor sentinel farm spore counts or begin monitoring your own counts.
